Here I sit in the middle of Germany (how do you like the name of the place?) Waiting for Uncle Sam to make up our minds what he wants me to do.

How's everyone in Arlington getting along? I guess that all of the excitement of school closing is in full swing now.

I've seen a lot of Germany since I came over here, as far as the country is concerned, it reminds me a lot of the States. It is far better than England and France. Some sections of mountain ranges resemble the Blue Ridge's.

I have been with the Sixth Army division since I came over. They have really made a good record for themselves since they landed in France, D +36.

If I had been with them, I would have had a few more points toward getting out. About now, that would really look good.

We aren't doing much now, just waiting to see if it's the C.B.J, Army of Occ. Or a very slim chance, back to the States for furlough. I hope it is the last one but then the C.B.J. afterwards.
