Right now I am in the infirmary with Yellow Jaundice. I've been here a week and have another ten days or so yet.

Jimmy Ballard just got over a case of jaundice and is now home on furlough. I'm looking for a furlough when I get out of here, but can't be too sure of getting it. Ordinarily I wouldn't get a furlough until I finished my training, which will be about a year from now.
